## Camp Out

Ogden Lake has two camp sites A and B. A can handle up to 200 people. B can handle up to 150. The difference in price: \$125 per night for A if you reserve for 3 nights. B is \$75 per night. There are no hookups. There isn't electricity. There are metal outhouses. There is potable drinking water. There is a creek. There are picnic tables. Paulina or East Crossing are nearby. There is also a waterfall, right up the road. Timing would be important, since mosquitos traditionally have been a problem in Paulina. This may not be an issue since we are looking at the end of the camping season. It is available the 25-28th of August.

Kim suggested that we keep the cost low (~\$10-\$15) and try to get more people there.

Kim motioned that we reserve camp site B at Ogden State Park for our third camping trip of the year Aug 25-28. Reed seconded. All approved.
