It is misleading to hint or give the impression that A.A. solves other problems or knows what to do about drug addiction. (*The AA Group page 18*)
- Closed meetings are for A.A. members only, or for those who have a drinking problem and "have a desire to stop drinking." Non-alcoholics may attend open meetings as observers. (The AA Group page 13)
- "Our Literature preserves the integrity of the AA message" (Big Book- Forward to the 4th)
- If your meeting should dissolve, change times or locations, or discontinue, your contact will let the schedule chair know so that we may keep the local directory current.
